OBITUARY  
PAULDING DALLAS NEW ERA  
March 6, 1884

" Death of an Old Citizen.- It is with regret that we are called upon to chronicle the death of one of Paulding's oldest and most honored citizens, Mr. William S. Hogue which occured at his residence, Tuesday the 26th of Feb., resulting from pneumonia. He was about 85 years of age and was one of the first settlers of Paulding County. In his younger days he was honored by his people with the office of sheriff, having been the first sheriff ever elected in the county. Afterwards he was County Surveyor for many years. Paulding County then embraced a good deal if the territory belonging to Polk and Haralson counties and the county site was at Van Wert. He was for many years a consistent member of the Primitive Baptist church, and died in the triumph of the Faith."

In 1879 William S. Hogue sold land lots # 1100 and 82 in the 19th district 3rd section of Paulding County to a J.J. Hogue. This deed is recorded at the Paulding County Court House.
